BEWARE: Fake Microsoft Pop-up

A new virus is circulating around libraries. The new bug displays a pop-up window, warns users the computer is infected, and instructs them to contact a support number. KnowBe4 wrote an article with in-depth information.

The pop-up page cannot be closed so here is what you need to do:

- Kill the browser using your Task Manager (ctrl+alt+delete) OR reboot the computer
- Reboot computer
- Download and run Malwarebytes in safe mode
- Send in a support ticket to help@librarieswin.org
- Include screenshots of the Malwarebytes results in help ticket
